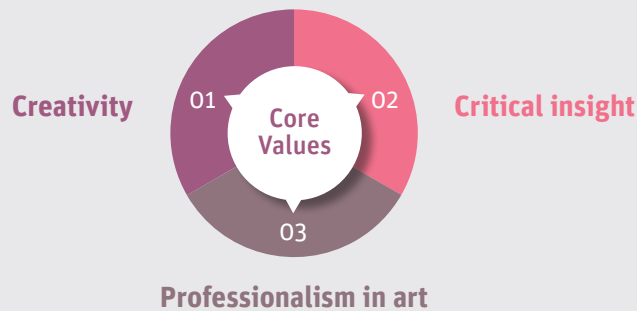
About the department

In addition to traditional paintings and drawings, there are training spaces, equipment, and curriculum-expanding expression media such as photography, video, three dimensional art, and installation art. This department is divided into Oriental painting and Western painting. Freshmen commonly learn drawing, Korean ink painting techniques, and three dimensional art, focusing on the basics. Sophomores and juniors are deeply trained in their majors. They come to learn how to materialize their works using digital media with various materials. Seniors who are due to graduate have open critiques of their graduation works.

Graduate Program



The Graduate School of Fine Arts is divided into Oriental painting, Western painting, and art history. Depending on their major, students experiment with a variety of mediums and investigate contemporary art. They are also trained to develop critical insights through seminars and critiques. Art History majors critically examine the understanding and current status of art history belonging to various cultures. They also critically examine contemporary art. They learn to understand visual culture based on various theory classes and develop objective analytical skills and acquire research methods.
